Dear DBHDS Licensed Providers and Stakeholders,

2024 continues to a busy and productive year for DBHDS! Between January 1st and June 30th, the Office of Licensing approved 429 location modifications and 389 service modifications; and licensed approximately 311 new providers. During that same timeframe, the office also conducted approximately 683 investigations and 2,616 inspections.

Throughout this quarter, several DBHDS offices worked diligently to prepare for the crisis services regulatory changes that took effect on July 17th, 2024. DBHDS offered the Crisis Services Regulatory Training for licensed providers of crisis services on July 10th. This training was developed by the Office of Licensing in collaboration with the Division of Crisis Services and the Office of Human Rights. A lot of information was covered! If you were unable to attend, we hope you will take the opportunity to review the crisis training documents located on the OL website. Our aim is to ensure that providers have a thorough understanding of the crisis regulatory changes and how these changes affect crisis services going forward.

Since January 1st, 2024, there have been 11,035 death or serious incidents (DSIs) reported to the department. 655 of these incidents met the individual care concern threshold criteria. 96.67% of DSIs were reported on-time. Kudos to providers for continuing to do a great job with reporting incidents!

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CONNECT Reminders

Please remember that the CONNECT Help Desk is only able to offer support with issues directly related to the CONNECT System. For issues related to licensing, the provider should contact their assigned Licensing Specialist or <u>licensingadminsupport@dbhds.virginia.g</u> <u>ov</u>.

All providers have access to view their most current license in the CONNECT Provider Portal. Be sure to review this information for accuracy and immediately report any discrepancies to your Licensing Specialist.

Information Modifications can be used to change the name of the Provider organization and to report organizational structure changes, however this does not include the Change of Ownership process. Providers must follow the Change of Ownership process beginning with notifying the Office of Licensing using the link in the Provider Portal Dashboard.

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Modification Type/Menu	When to submit this type of application:
Add New Service	This type of modification, along with the required supporting documentation, will need to be submitted if a provider wants to add a NEW service/license. This option is found at the top of the Active Licenses on the Provider Portal Dashboard.
View/Add New Location	This type of modification, along with the required supporting documentation, will need to be submitted if a provider wants to add an additional location to an existing service OR relocate a service requiring a change in physical address from one location to another. *If a provider is changing their address (moving their current location to another physical location), the provider will also need to submit an Information Modification to close the current location/address (see below).
	Note for Sponsored Residential Services: If a provider currently holds a license for a sponsored residential service, they will not submit a location modification to add the location. The sponsored provider will need to follow the <u>Sponsored Provider Certification Process</u> (<u>November 2021</u>). Please use this <u>Sponsored Certification Form</u> when requesting to add additional Sponsored Residential Locations.
Information Modification	This type of modification, along with the required supporting documentation, must be submitted to make general changes. The appropriate information modification type must be selected for the Office of Licensing to process your request for change. If the correct information modification type is not selected, the Information Modification will be withdrawn by the OL and the provider will be advised to resubmit.
	The Information Modification can be submitted for the following reasons: • Provider Name Change (include SCC certificate) • Organizational Structure Change (include organization chart) • Close Provider Organization • Service Description Change • Geographical Area Served Change • Population Served Change (Age, Gender, Disability) • Close Service o Number of Beds or Capacity Change • Demographic Information Change • Building or Home Modification Change • Close Location • Other Modification (Use for changing Main Authorized Contact)
